

BABES IN ARMS POLICY

It is the case that all patrons attending our shows (including minors/babies) must have a valid full price ticket for entry.

Our Babes In Arms policy is as follows:

If taking your infant into the venue, please be aware of the following concerns:

- Every patron attending the performance must have a valid individual ticket for admission – this includes Babes in Arms*
- This is a licensed venue, alcohol will be served*
- No crèche facilities are available and all babies/children/minors must be accompanied by an adult at all times*
- Thousands of adults will be in attendance and dancing*
- Lack of light during a performance can be particularly hazardous when bringing a child with you*
- Production elements such as loud music, bright lights, pyrotechnic stage effects and show content can cause distress to infants/minors*
- The potential for someone to knock, bump or push you/your infant causing injury*
- The potential for disturbance to other patrons by crying or restless infants/minors*

The Promoters do not consider this event suitable for children under the age of two years.

As the safety of children, parents and all patrons is of paramount importance to us, these concerns are brought to your attention for your consideration, so that you, your family and all other patrons can enjoy the show in a safe and comfortable environment.
